\_\_\_\_\_ **SPRING IS HERE** Students will discover how to compost, the importance of water, how to identify plants and what seeds need to grow. They will plant a seedling to take home or to plant in your school garden. **Thursday April 5, 2012.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **EARTH AND ARBOR DAY** Learn about conservation! Students will make recycled paper, explore water pollution, plant a plant or tree to take home or plant in your school garden, and make a wacky planter from reusable materials. **Thursday April 19, 2012.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **BUTTERFLIES, BIRDS & CINCO DE MAYO** Take flight with monarchs while learning about butterfly migration, explore plants that attract butterflies and birds to your garden (and take a plant home with you!), identify birds by their beaks, and learn a little Spanish in our Cinco de Mayo Activity. **Thursday May 3, 2012.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **GOING GREEN IN THE GARDEN** Green isn't just a color! Come explore the Children's Garden and learn about what it really means to be Green. Students will learn about alternative forms of energy, participate in a recycling relay, examine conservation activities that you can do in your own backyard, and learn how plants help prevent indoor air pollution while planting a seedling to take home or to plant in your school garden. **Thursday May 17, 2012.**
